Cryosurgery “Freeze-Firing”

Note:

Please call EVC with any questions or concerns. As with any surgical procedure, complications can develop and early intervention can help return your patient to health more rapidly.

- * Keep surgery sight **unbandaged** for 5-7 days
- * Apply **Furacin spray** topically 1 time per day to surgery site
- * If on lower limb, begin bandaging surgery site after initial 5-7 day period with alcohol or Furacin / DMSO sweat.
- * At this point, also begin 1-2 grams **Phenylbutazone** per day to help manage residual edema or swelling. Cold hosing is also an option.
- * Allow scabs to form at surgery site and detach from skin by themselves.
- * Expect the eventual in-growth of **white hairs** at the surgery sites.

Note:

Expect some degree of mild swelling, heat and sensitivity for up to 2 weeks after the procedure.

Local anesthetics (10-14 day race withdrawal) were used during this procedure.
