Shin “Scraping”

NOTE:

Please call EVC with any questions or concerns. As with any surgical procedure, complications can develop and early intervention can help return your patient to health more rapidly.

With this particular procedure, NSAIDs and antimicrobials DO NOT need to be administered to patient as long as exceptionally clean bandages are maintained throughout aftercare.

Day 2-5:

- * Clean old Biozide and dried discharge from skin with clean, dry towel.
- * Apply new Biozide liberally to dorsal aspect of cannon bones and immediately cover with new Conform and clean cotton standing bandages.

Day 6-10:

- * Patient can receive first bath.
- * Lightly scrub clean dorsal aspect of cannon bones and apply alcohol, new Conform and clean cotton standing bandages.

Exercise:

- * Strict stall rest with only hand walking (up to 30 minutes with bandages on) for 1 week.
- * Return to jogging for 1 week.
- * Return to galloping.
- * First “Breeze” after at least 2 weeks of galloping.
